The General Induction for Construction Work – White Card course is required to work in a construction site in Australia. Unit CPCCOHS1001A provides general induction training specified by the National Code of Practice for Induction for Construction Work.

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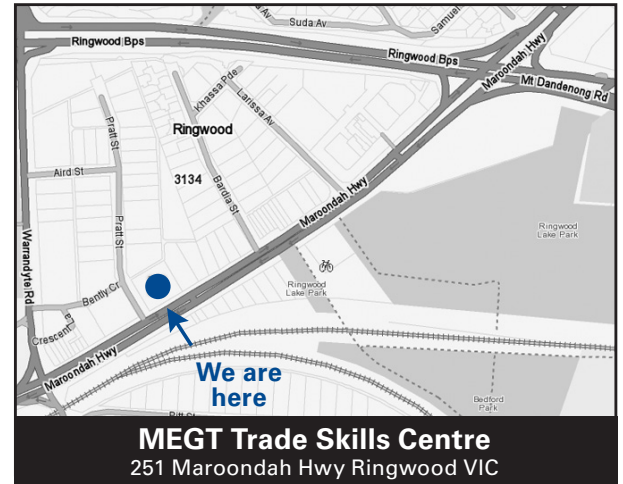


Flexible training options
