

# White Card Training



## What is White Card?

White Card is the common name for WorkSafe Victoria's Construction Induction Course. It is required to work on any construction site.

The White Card was previously known as the Red Card.

WorkSafe Victoria has endorsed the Nationally Recognised Training unit Work Safely in the Construction Industry (CPCCOHS1001A).  Elements of this unit are:

- identify OHS legislative requirements
- identify construction hazards and control measures
- identify OHS communication and reporting processes
- identify OHS incident response procedures.

White Card Training provides explanation of the applicable legislation and regulations for the construction industry. Participants will be assessed by written/oral short answer questions and written report and a demonstration of applying skills and knowledge in a workplace context. Upon successful completion MEGT Institute will submit your White Card application to WorkSafe. WorkSafe will dispatch your WorkSafe Induction Card directly to you.
